If I am nervous about going I can talk to someone and ask questions first I can call 01506 284924



I can ask the library staff for a tour of the library



About the Library

There are people who work at the library who I can talk to and who can help me.



There is a children's library where I can look at all the different books.



The Library is usually a quiet place where people talk quietly, relax and read books.



If it is noisy I can ask a person who works in the library to help me find a quiet spot



I can ask a person who works in the library for a tour of the library so that I know where things are.



If I would like to do some drawing or colouring in, there are crafts on the table for me to use.



The toilets are really close to the library but if I can't find them I can ask a person who works at the library to show me where they are



How I become a member of the library

When I get to the library I will see a desk, this is where library staff will be if I need help.



I will talk to someone who works there to become a member of the library.



I will tell them my name, address, date of birth, telephone number and email address

I will show them 2 forms of identification if I am over 18 years old. One piece of identification has to have my address on it. This can be a driving licence, bank statement or household bill.

If I am a child I do not need ID but a parent/guardian has to sign on my behalf.

I will sign a form, this makes me a member of the library and I will be given a library card. If I am over 18 years old I will be given the card titled "Adult Library Card".

If I am a child I will be given a child's card with cows on it.

When I visit the library

In the library there will be shelves of books and audio books that I can borrow



I can sit in a chair to read a book and I can borrow a book or audio book and take it home with me.




If I want to borrow a book I will talk to a member of the library staff
